Hello to all the co-owners,

We are pleased to have an herb garden again this year. The committee members are Manon Doré and Pierre Mackay. **All those who wish to join the committee are welcome.** 

You have already noticed that most of the perennial herbs have grown well this spring: oregano; chives; lemon balm; lovage; thyme; a little sage; and some pansies have reseeded.

We ask that you don't start picking these herbs until mid June to give them a chance to get established. Oregano is so abundant and well established that it can begin to be harvested in small quantities.

We have installed signs to indicate when the plants will be ready for picking.



Again this year, we will be writing information sheets about the herbs in the garden. We will keep the same format as last summer's sheets to explain their characteristics: description, cultivation, nutritional and medicinal value and a recipe or two so that you can fully enjoy the garden.

We ask that you wait until the plants have reached a reasonable size before picking leaves or stems. We also ask that you do not make extensive cuts. The next newsletter will contain information on how to pick herbs in a way that optimizes their growth for the benefit of all.

Hope to see you in the garden all summer long!
